ACTIONS COMPLETED/ON-GOING FOR THIS PERIOD:

- This committee met on January 4/10 and on Feb.3/10
- The Youth Minister and 3 members of the committee were in attendance at the February 3/20 meeting.
- The business arising from the agenda were : **Religion in Life Certificates, the storage situation in the brick building and the White Church, an update on the painting project, the Sunday School service for March 7/10 and the need for a Scouting representative for CD.**
- Under new business the following was reviewed: **Camp Bursary for Needy Kids – Youth Forum, the Volunteer Screening Policy, the recruitment of 2-3 more members for the committee, the possible painting of the library , the development of the Mission Statement, a review of the Sunday School teacher job description, an addendum to the budget of \$250.00 for the AV License and the budget for 2010 will remain at \$5000.00 and the Sunday School Picnic for Shubie Park in June**
- The committee felt that they made a **major contribution to Woodlawn’s 125th anniversary with the Painting Project** and wanted everyone who took part to know how much they were appreciated by this wonderful effort.
- The Youth Minister reported on many of the items under old business and new business and **in particular on the Youth Fourm, the Painting Project, the Mission Statement, the job description of our Sunday School Teachers, the painting of the library and who owns it (?) and the new envelopes to be used for the Sunday School and Youth re: collection.**
- The Youth Minister reported that there are now 39 Youth coming to Woodlawn and that there are now 62 children on our Sunday School
