Over the last month Trustees have been consumed with furnace upgrades in an attempt to make sure we can provide a warm inviting sanctuary as the temperatures drop. Like all renovations or upgrades there is always more effort needed than originally thought. The heating system is proving to be right up there with needing more and more efforts. We are confident however that we are on the home stretch and all will be warm soon.

Since the Patterson House office upgrades we have been planning to replace to windows in Donna's office. That is still in the plan but we are having an energy audit undertaken as part of the Dept. of Energy's program that we believe will then allow us to qualify for provincial grants, we are on a waiting list to have the analysis undertaken. Along with the windows we would like to insulate the heating pipes in the main church building which will save us on our fuel consumption.

Investments remain as per previous reports. I would point out that as most of you are aware we did receive in the form of Mutual fund transfer a sizable contribution towards the organ fund (\$31,300).
